

## TO CHECK FOR A LEAK

- 1) Go to the pit, lift off the metal lid (it weighs approximately 2 pounds), sit the radio read box aside (if it's not attached to the pit lid), and lift out the styrofoam pillow.
- 2) THE MASTER METER WILL NEVER OVER READ.
- 3) If the triangle or the dial on your meter is turning, you are using water.

## TO BETTER LOCATE YOUR LEAK

Shut the water off in the house.

If your meter has a triangle:

If the triangle is still moving, the leak is in the yard. If it is NOT moving, the problem is in the house (ie. water softener, toilet, etc.).

If your meter has a black or red dial:

You must watch the dial for a longer period of time, as it will run very slowly. If the dial is turning the leak is in the yard. If it is NOT moving, the problem is in the house.

If you need us to check for a leak, there will be a \$50.00 service call fee.

\*\*\* Smaller leaks: Try putting food coloring in the **tank** of your toilet in the evening and check the **bowl** of the toilet in the morning. If food coloring has seeped into the bowl, your stool is leaking.
